



Bishop Stopford's School - Sixth Form Admission Criteria

Academic:

Level 3 Academic Pathway (A Levels) – Total point score of at least 35 points must include passes (Grade 4 or higher) in Maths and either English Language or English Literature. You will need to gain a Grade 6 or better in each of the subjects you wish to study.

Level 3 Vocational Pathway (BTec) – Total point score of at least 25 points, to include passes (Grade 4 or higher) in Maths and either English Language or English Literature. If you have previously studied the subject at L2 you will need to have gained a Merit in order to progress to the L3 course.

Level 3 Hybrid Pathway (A Level & BTEC) – Total point score of at least 25 points, to include passes (Grade 4 or higher) in Maths and either English Language or English Literature. You will need to gain a Grade 6 or higher in each of the subjects you wish to study as A levels.

Level 2 Foundation Pathway – Total point score of at least 20 points.
