Level 3 (A Levels) – 5 A* - B including a Grade 6 in both English and Maths and a Grade 6 in the GCSE Level subjects of choice. Please see the prospectus for more detailed entry requirements.

Level 3 (BTec) – 5 A* - C including a Grade C in both English and Maths.

If you do not achieve the set of GCSE qualifications required to follow a Level 3 AS/BTec course next year, you may stay on to complete a Level 2 programme.

This will consist of Core GCSE English and Maths including a choice of Business, Health and Social Care, Engineering, Art or Sport.

All students studying A Level will be required to also study the EPQ qualification.

If you do not achieve the set of GCSE qualifications required to follow a Level 3 AS/BTec course next year, you may stay on to complete a Level 2 programme.

Notes:

- To transfer to Level 3 courses, you should have at least 5 grade 5's including English and Maths (grade 6's for A level).
- Level 3 applicants must choose three subjects plus EPQ.
- Level 2 applicants must follow re-sit English and Maths if they have not achieved at least a Grade 4. Students will have some choices but these may be restricted based on the timetable.

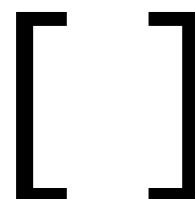
