Exam Requirements Sociology AQA 8192

Students will take two exams at the end of year 11 (each is 1 hour and 45 minutes).

Paper 1: Family and Education

Paper 2: Crime & Deviance and Social Stratification.

Both exams contain a mixture of multiple choice questions, short questions ranging from 1, 2, 3 & 4 marks answers, as well as two 12 mark essays for each topic (**family, education, crime, social stratification**).
