| Link to prior learning | Students further develop their understanding of working to meet a clients need through the use of a starting brief similar to that see in KS4. Students build on their understanding of artisstic research following a similar structured approach but applying this to new "modern" artissts. A further development of this is seen in the expansion of sources of information as well as a greater expected level of independant study.
