Dear Families,

As we approach the Easter break, we look forward to rest and rejuvenation. Easter is a time for new beginnings and re-focus. Over the last year, we have had to learn to adapt to different ways of living, working, learning and keeping ourselves and loved ones safe. I am so very proud of our students, they have been so resilient and risen to every challenge. The last few weeks back in school have been an absolute delight. I know that the staff and the students have really missed being together and learning together in their usual way. The classrooms and playground have once more been filled with joy and laughter reminding us again just how special our school is.

COVID TESTING DURING THE HOLIDAYS

During the Easter holidays we want our families to stay safe, whilst enjoying some relaxing of the Covid restrictions. As you are aware the school has been encouraging all of our families to take part in Lateral Flow testing to prevent the spread of the virus and prevent the virus from entering the school and impacting on our school community. Since our return, I am pleased to inform you that we have no reported positive cases of COVID-19. To help us to continue to protect your child and others in the school, please ensure that you continue to test twice a week throughout the Easter holidays and on the evening of Sunday 18th April before we return to school on the 19th April. The school will be sending home additional test kits this week to all families.

The School and you still have a role to play in track and trace for positive cases once we have closed. You will only need to notify **the School** by email at covid@bishopstopfords.enfield.sch.uk about a child testing positive for COVID-19 if they develop symptoms before midnight on 3rd April, 2021. If they were last in school on 1st April, this will allow us to track all school contacts within the preceding 48-hour period, so that we may inform them of the need to isolate for 10 days.

If a child tests positive using a Lateral Flow test (LTD) at home this should be followed up with a PCR test. We ask that once tested, if you or someone in your household is positive, you email the school immediately at covid@bishopstopfords.enfield.sch.uk. This will apply if the school is open or closed. We will be monitoring this email address to help ensure that effective plans are in place to mitigate against the spread of the virus. If your child develops symptoms from Sunday, 4th April 2021, the School does not need to take further action, but you should engage with the NHS test and trace service. The School may contact you up until 7th April to notify you of positive cases.

The Department for Education coronavirus (COVID-19) helpline will be open every day over the Easter holidays to answer any questions you have about coronavirus (COVID-19) relating to education settings and children's social care. Over the bank holiday weekend (Friday 2 April to Monday 5 April), lines will be open from 10am to 4pm. Phone: 0800 046 8687

ENSURING THAT YOU RECEIVE YOUR FREE SCHOOL MEALS, IF ELIGIBLE

All those in receipt of Free School Meals will receive an eCode Payment Voucher for the Easter Holidays 2nd-16th April – this is for £45. The e-code will be issued by Edenred and will be sent to your e-mail address. Please note this code must be redeemed by the 7th April (it cannot be reissued) but the supermarket voucher can be spent after this date.
