Dear Parent/Carer,

As we approach the end of an extremely busy term which has included; marking and moderating Year 11 and 13 GCSE exams, preparing students in Years 10 and 12 for their upcoming trial exams and supporting students in Year 7-9 through their end of year exams, I would like to remind you of some of our most basic standards ready for the final half term.

<u>Uniform</u>

Please continue to ensure your son/daughter meets our high standards when it comes to uniform. This includes the following areas:

- Students must wear black shoes, not trainers. If a student has a medical reason not to wear shoes, we should have this in writing from a doctor.
- Students must wear a blazer to and from school, and whilst they are in school.
- Students are not allowed to wear hoodies in school, as a coat, or under their blazers
- Students must wear a school tie at all times and it should not be removed during the school day
- Student coats must be blue or black only. Denim and leather coats are not allowed to be worn
- School PE kit must be worn on the days a student has PE. If they do not have the school PE kit
 they must wear Black or Blue appropriate clothing
- Students are expected to put airpods, headphones and mobile devices away before entering the school building

Equipment

Please use the holiday as an opportunity to stock up on equipment ready for the final term. Students should have plenty of pens (black/blue and green), pencils, highlighters, glue sticks, a maths set that includes protractor and compass and a scientific calculator.

Students in Year 10 and 12 sitting their trial exams should have a clear pencil case in order to adhere to exam regulations.
