Progress 8 -0.04

This score shows how much progress pupils at this school made between the end of key stage 2 and the end of key stage 4, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 2.

Attainment 8 41.7

Schools get a score based on how well pupils have performed in up to 8 qualifications, which include English, maths, 3 English Baccalaureate qualifications including sciences, computer science, history, geography and languages, and 3 other additional approved qualifications.

Grade 5 or above in English & maths GCSEs 33%

The percentage of pupils who achieved grade 5 or above in English and maths GCSEs.

EBacc average point score 3.39

The EBacc APS calculates a pupil's average point scores across the 5 pillars of the English Baccalaureate, allocating points to a pupil's best grades and dividing by 6 (the science grades count in 2 pillars, meaning a total of 6 pillars) to create an average point score per pupil. This measure is an average across the subjects (i.e. we divide the total by 6) and so is on a different scale to Attainment 8 which we calculated by simply awarding points score across 8 qualifications (without dividing the total).

Staying in education or entering employment 88%

This shows the number of pupils who either stayed in education or went into employment after finishing key stage 4 for at least two terms. This is for pupils who finished year 11 in 2020. This figure covers any sustained education or employment destination.

1% of students started and stayed in employment during this time.

2% of students did not stay in education, apprenticeships or employment for at least two terms. The remaining 9% of students have a destination that is unknown by the data sources at the DFE.
